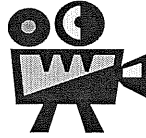
Summer Trek

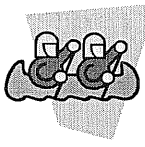
Thursday, June 21

General Description of Programming:
Delano Community Education Summer Trek 2008

We will continue this summer with 8 individual days of Summer Trek. Thus, students can pick and choose days and field trip destinations that interest them and fit into their schedules. They will not need to commit to a full week at a time. We will use the same format of either offering a day-long field trip or a combination of a shorter field trip plus activities at the Tiger Activity Center. Each day will run from 9 a.m. to approximately 5 p.m., depending on field trip plans. The program will be offered on selected days across the entire summer.

This year's field trip destinations include -

1. Water Park of America
2. MN Zoo (we will see an IMAX movie while there)
3. Science Museum (We will experience the huge "Star Wars" exhibit and watch the movie "Special Effects" in the Omni Theater)
4. Way Cool Cooking School
5. Twins Game
6. Cascade Bay Water Park
7. Canoeing at Three Rivers Park
8. Alien's café / Crystal Cove Water Park

Two of the trips will be offered along with Discovery Zone field trips so children of all ages within a family can attend.

Summer Trek participants who are not students in or residents of the Delano school district will be charged a higher fee for participation. The higher fee is designed to acknowledge the financial support of the program by the City of Delano and to assure that the funding directly benefits our residents.
