Approve a request from St. Peter Catholic Church/School for a Street Dance on June 5, 2010.

BACKGROUND

St. Peter's Catholic Church and School is proposing to conduct a street dance on June 5th from 9 pm to 1:00 am on River Street North. The request includes closing of River Street from Bridge Ave to Railroad Ave., selling strong beer and conducting a dance with music to be performed by Butch Automatic. Dave Carroll from Dave's Town Club is the event chairman and is a representative for the Church School Board. Temporary Strong Beer License may be issued to religious organizations. The Church will supply additional garbage collection devices, and mini biffs for the event. Security will be handled by volunteers from the school to prevent underage drinking. They plan on using a wrist band verification system, as well. Wright County Highway will need to approve the closure of River Street as this is also a County Road. The application also includes a request that any City Fees be waived. Mike Windsberger is planning on selling his mini doughnuts out of his vending trailer with the proceeds going to the parochial school. The Shelby Family will be selling hot dogs and sandwiches from their Scooter Dawgs Vending trailer. A representative will be at the meeting to answer any questions that the council may have. The Church is supplying the General Liability and Liquor Liability insurance with the city being named as additional insured.
