

**CITY OF DELANO  
ORDINANCE O-10-\_\_\_\_**

**Ordinance amending City Code Chapter 5 (Licensing and Regulation of Alcoholic Beverages), Section 503.01 (License Required), Subdivision 8 (On-Sale Wine License Required) and Subdivision 12 (Caterer's, Special Provisions)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Delano issues licenses regarding the sale of alcoholic beverages in accordance with Minnesota State Statute Chapter 340A;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Delano desires to authorize the sale of strong beer by certain on-sale wine licensees without an additional license in accordance with the terms of this ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Delano desires to amend terms related to caterer's permits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE DELANO CITY COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**Section 1.** Subdivision 8 of Delano City Code Section 503.01 is hereby amended by adding the following to the end of the Subdivision:

“Any person who holds an on-sale wine license who is also licensed to sell 3.2% malt liquors at on-sale, and whose gross receipts are at least 60% attributable to the sale of food, may sell strong beer without an additional license.”

**Section 2.** Subdivision 12 (A) of Delano City Code Section 503.01 is hereby amended by deleting “The City Council” and replacing it with “The Minnesota Commissioner of Public Safety”.

**Section 3** Subdivision 12 (E) of Delano City Code Section 503.01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The permittee shall notify the Wright County Sheriff no later than 7 days prior to any catered event.”

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
